Closed Session begins at 6:00 p.m., with Open Session to follow at 7:00 p.m. Note: time is approximate, pending the duration of the closed session. Interested citizens and business representatives are welcome to attend.

Any person who answers yes to any of the following are not permitted to attend the meeting. Within the previous 14 days, have you:

- a. visited China, Iran, South Korea, any European countries, or any other high-risk countries identified by the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention);
- b. traveled domestically within the United States where COVID-19 has sustained widespread community transmission;
- c. been asked to quarantine, isolate, or self-monitor by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
- d. been diagnosed with, or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, COVID-19;
 - e. had a fever, cough, or shortness of breath; or
 - f. resided with or been in close contact with any person in the above-mentioned category

- 7. The public question/comment period is to receive input from citizens and businesses. *It is not appropriate for the audience to repeatedly engage conversations with council.*
