Any person who answers yes to any of the following are not permitted to attend the meeting. Within the previous 14 days, have you:

- a. visited China, Iran, South Korea, any European countries, or any other high-risk countries identified by the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention);
- b. traveled domestically within the United States where COVID-19 has sustained widespread community transmission;
- c. been asked to quarantine, isolate, or self-monitor by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
- d. been diagnosed with, or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, COVID-19;
- e. had a fever, cough, or shortness of breath; or
- f. resided with or been in close contact with any person in the above-mentioned category
