- c. been asked to quarantine, isolate, or self-monitor by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
- d. been diagnosed with, or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, COVID-19;
  - e. had a fever, cough, or shortness of breath; or
  - f. resided with or been in close contact with any person in the above-mentioned category

- 7. The public question/comment period is to receive input from citizens and businesses. *It is not appropriate for the audience to engage in conversations with council or members of the public.*
