Council Meeting Minutes
June 15th, 2022

Hurt Town Council held a called meeting on Wednesday, June 15th, 2022, at Town Hall. The meeting opened at 7:00 PM by Mayor Gary Hodnett with a quorum present.

Roll Call

Tonight's meeting was for any of the Town of Hurt residents to come in and speak on the Budget. Town Council waited until 7:15pm for any citizen to come. In the meantime, while waiting, Council discussed next weeks meeting where voting to approve the budget will take place. The meeting next week will be Wednesday 22nd starting with closed session at 6pm, and open session to follow. Attorney Eller stated the approval of the budget had to be 7 days from today.

Council also discussed the water leak on Roark street. Mr. Smith was showing the pipe that had been hit due to no blueprints to show where the water pipe/line ran. Mr. Smith stated he tried for several months to receive blueprints and could never get ahold of them, until two days after the pipe was hit. Mayor Hodnett told Attorney Eller he would like for him to write something up to Cable Protection Services and have them pay for the bill due to lack of marking the lines.

Mr. Poindexter brought in the discussion about a new rates and fee master list. Discussed that a new one of those will need to be done. As well as discussing about the July monthly Council meeting. The discussion was to decide whether Council wanted to have the meeting on the first Tuesday of the month or to move it further in July due to July 4th weekend and families with plans. This meeting will be decided on June 22nd.

Due to no citizens showing up for the Public Hearing we adjourned.
