## Town of Hurt, Virginia Called Council Meeting Minutes October 13, 2022

Hurt Town Council held a called meeting on Thursday, October 13, 2022. The meeting opened at approximately 6:00 PM with a quorum present. Following preliminaries, a public hearing on water and wastewater connection fees was opened at 6:10 PM. One resident spoke in reference to the fees, indicating he was concerned that the town was planning to move forward with town sewerage based on what he had heard and read. The resident expressed that he already had a perfectly good septic drain field and did not want to have to hook up to town sewer. Upon explanation of exactly what these fees were, it became evident there had been a misunderstanding and the resident closed his comments. There being no additional public input, the public hearing was closed at 6:15 PM.

A brief discussion between council members followed, reminding everyone these fees were designed to take in industrial hookups as well as recalculating both residential and industrial hookups costs to bring fairness to all. After brief discussion, a motion was made to accept the proposed changes in water and wastewater connection and hookup fees as written.
