Town of Hurt, Virginia Called Council Meeting Minutes October 20, 2022

Hurt Town Council held a called meeting on Thursday, October 20, 2022. The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:01 PM with a quorum present. Mayor Hodnett thanked everyone for attending and moved through the preliminaries quickly.

A public hearing was opened at 6:10 PM for discussion of newly proposed water and wastewater transfer fees and infrastructure repair/maintenance fees. No one in attendance at the public hearing offered to speak on these topics. The floor was held open until 6:15 PM to allow for any late arrivals who may request to speak, though no one did so.

Council held a brief discussion on the new fee structure and a motion was made to accept the proposed fee structure as presented. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Mayor Hodnett concluded by stating that PSN, the town's online water and tax payment system, was working great. Around 28% of our residents have set up their own accounts with PSN and make their payments via PSN. Another 15% simply call Town Hall requesting to make their payments via their credit card and we take their payments over the phone. This is totaling almost half of our accounts. Only two years ago the total number of residents paying online was about 4. This convenience for our residents is a huge success.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at approximately 7:05 PM.
